Ms Nausicaa attends Tianyi Talk



On November 18th, our Drama Teacher Ms Nausicaa Giavarra was invited to participate in a key event of the 2022 Maritime Silk Road Culture and Tourism Expo, Tianyi Talk which was hosted by Tianyige Museum. It took Voices from Three Ancient Libraries in Italy and China as its theme. Zhuang Lizhen, the curator of Tianyige Museum, Silvia Scipioni, the curator of Medici Lorenzo Library, and Elisabetta Bovero, the curator of Malatestan Library, conducted a "cloud dialogue" and signed the "Ningbo Consensus", issuing a global call for the initiative to establish the World Alliance of Libraries.



Ms Nausicaa said, "it has been a great honour to witness and contribute to sealing the agreement between the three oldest private libraries in the world at such a significant cultural event. Tian Yi Library has always been one of my favourite places in Ningbo. It is a peaceful and inspiring place. And both the Malatesta and Laurentian Medici libraries in Italy are fascinating. I'm glad I had the opportunity to learn more about these incredible cultural sites, their history, and their collections. The event made me even more proud of my mother country and Ningbo, my second home".

We learned Haiku in our poetry unit. Students learned about the rules of Haiku and also had fun writing their own Haiku poems about nature.

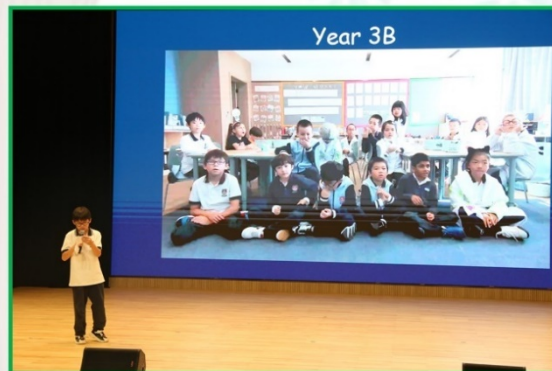


Primary Assembly 21.11.22

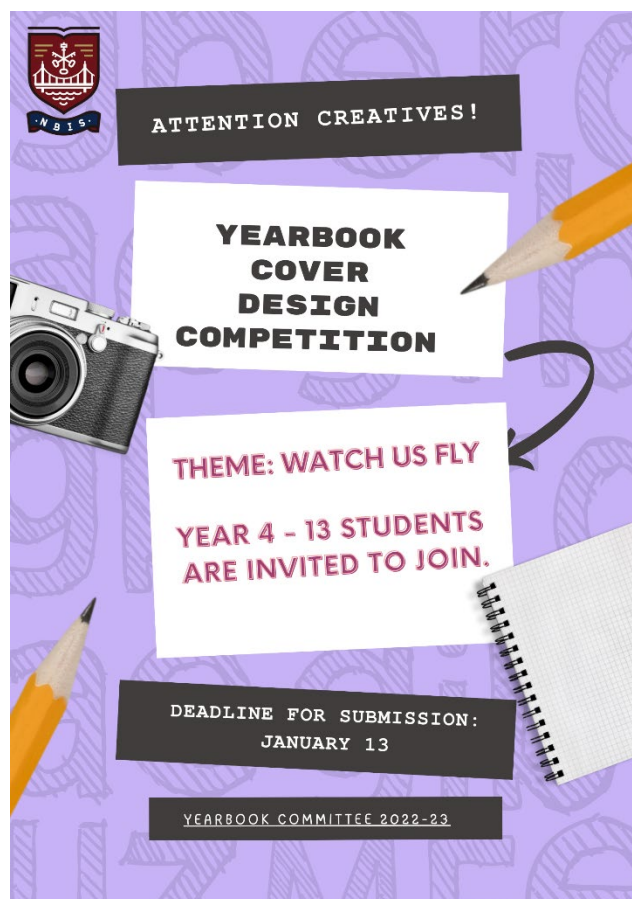

Selection criteria: Yearbook Committee will be looking at the aesthetics, concept, and significance of your design.

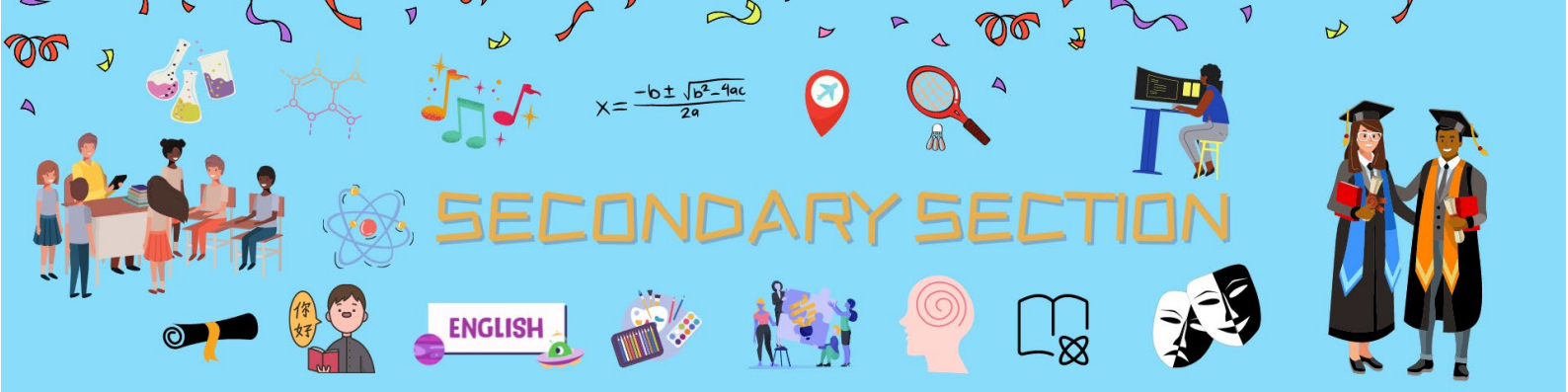

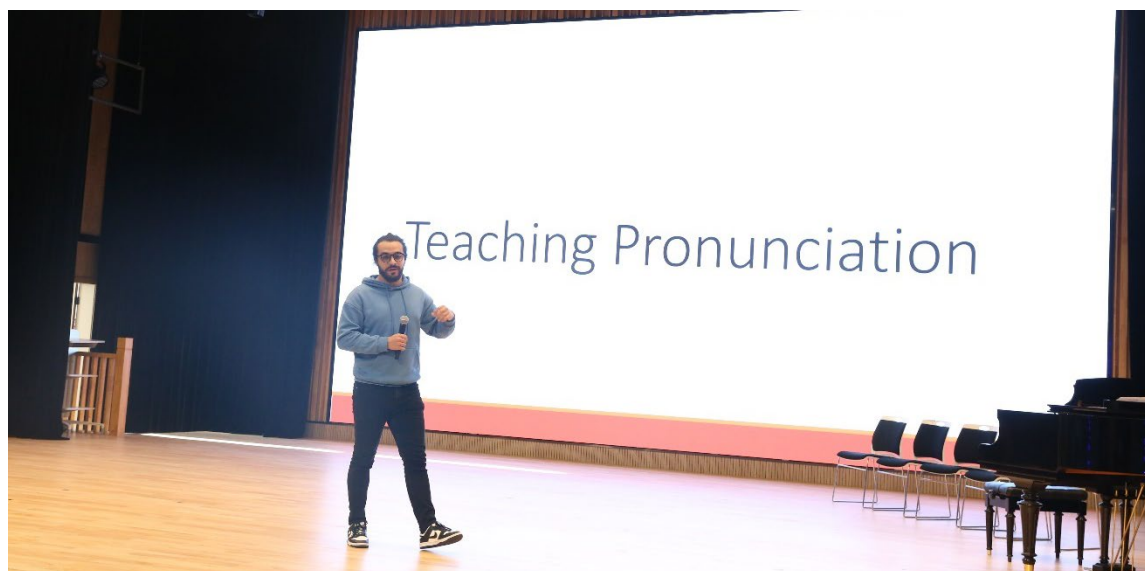

Teaching Pronunciation – A Presentation for Teachers from Mr Yassine Khaya



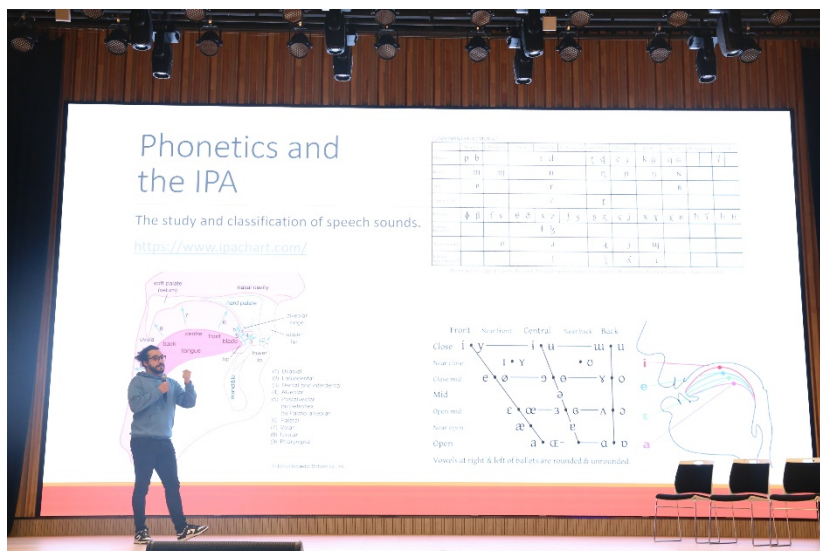
The presentation revolved around the topic of “Teaching Pronunciation”. It opened up by exploring some easy but deceptive questions such as: What’s language and why do we have accents? To answer that, the attendees were introduced to two different frameworks and each one attempted to deal with the question differently. On the one hand, seen from a traditional standpoint, language is prescriptive and its perfect form should be the only thing any learner strives for. On the other hand, seen from a modern structuralist view, language is conventional, fluid, flexible, and descriptive.



The presentation dove further into the topic of accents in second language learning. When a learner is acquiring a second language, they already have an inventory of sounds related to their first language. Therefore, when they experience the sounds available in the target language, they resort back to their native inventory, find the closest matching sound, and use it in the production of the target language. The catch here is that every language has an almost unique set of sounds, especially with vowels. For example, the closest two vowels in a first language and a target language may still have pitch, intonation, and tongue positioning differences; and those are the distinctions that go unnoticed for a learner.



In order to circumvent the issue discussed in the previous paragraph, teachers should take a proactive stance when helping with pronunciation. The presentation suggested the following plan: First, the features of the desired sound should be identified. Second, the features of the produced sound should be pinpointed. Finally, the teacher can guide the student through a step-by-step process; getting one thing right at a time. The part(s) of the mouth that are involved in the production (bilabial, labiodental, alveolar, etc.). The manner in which the sound is produced (voiced/voiceless, fricative, plosive, etc..).



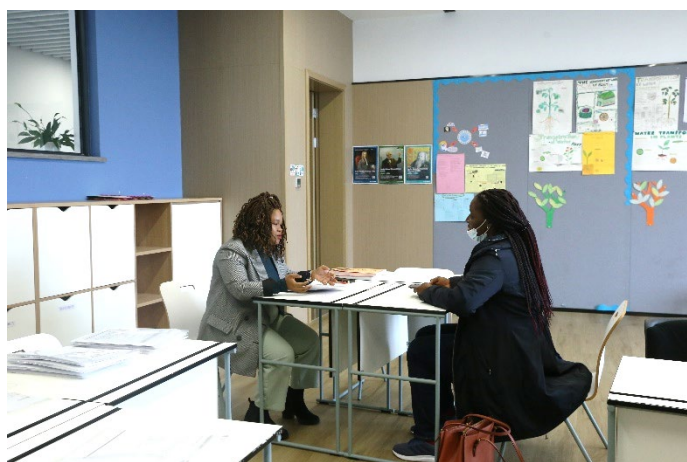
The breadth of such topic didn't discourage teachers from participating and raising pertinent questions.
