The WEG Board Meeting

The Wanli Education Group (WEG) held its NBIS board meeting for Semester 1 on Wednesday, January 17th, at Ningbo British International School (NBIS). The agenda centred on enhancing the educational experience for students, staff, and the school. Discussions included the leadership transition, celebrated departmental achievements, and outlined challenges and next steps to refine the school's improvement strategy.



Ms Nancy Eldars, the International Principal, updated attendees on progress made during the leadership transition and departmental accomplishments and noted challenges. She elaborated on the school's journey towards Council of International School accreditation, including the standards and expectations set by CIS. Mr Robert Yan, the Chinese Principal, highlighted NBIS's operational and financial stewardship and the measures taken to address challenges over the past three years.



Section Heads proposed initiatives and plans to improve student experiences, teacher professional development, and holistic education. They aim to foster an engaging, interactive learning environment that promotes creativity, academic excellence, critical thinking, and student well-being. They emphasised the importance of practical learning and interdisciplinary methods to serve 21st-century learners.



The Board also discussed infrastructure development, with updates on recent renovations, facility improvements, and the creation of new spaces for specialised activities. These efforts aim to provide students with a supportive learning environment equipped with modern facilities.

The WEG Board members were grateful to the Senior Leadership Team for their dedication to enhancing student achievements and experiences in Semester 1. They commended the efforts of staff, teachers, administration, and logistics personnel. The contributions of innovative teaching methods, improved teacher training, and infrastructure upgrades were highlighted as key factors in the school's ongoing growth.

WEG Board members acknowledged the collective efforts of all stakeholders and offered additional feedback on NBIS's dedication to delivering high-quality education. They emphasised their commitment to preparing students for success in a diverse learning community. With high expectations, the WEG Board pledged continued support for NBIS, guided by the principles of leading a community of learners through diversity, unity and excellence.

FOOTBALL FRIENDLY MATCH

The past Saturday, January 20th, NBIS football students experienced their first interschool game of the year. On this occasion, HD School hosted a match for the Lower Secondary Team and another match for the Upper Secondary Team.



The weather wasn't the best one but the turnout was amazing on the day. All the students were on time and willing to start the warm-up. Also, despite the cold and rain, many parents and NBIS staff were in HD School supporting the boys.



The first game of the day was for the Lower Secondary students, who started dominating the match having possession of the ball and generating chances quite often. Nevertheless, it was HD who scored the first goal from an unfortunate penalty kick.



It was at this moment when our students showed their personality and, instead of giving up, they kept calm and continued playing a good level of football knowing that the chances would arrive. Following this pattern, the equalizer came after a combination of passes and the ball arrived to the left side of the field, where Biel Das Cervera scored from a powerful crossed kick. In a similar way and with the same protagonist, Biel Das Cervera scored a second goal that made the crowd scream and jump with happiness. Last but not least, in the last minute of the game, NBIS had a corner kick that Nuutti Toiviainen amazingly crossed in and Stanley Mutunga pulled off a beautifully timed header into the top corner of the goal. What a great game for our young ones with a final 1-3 score! All the players showed their potential and performed at their maximum: goalkeeper, defenders, midfielders and strikers.



The second and last game of the day started right after that, with the Upper Secondary students as protagonists. The match didn't start in the best way for us. In the first minutes NBIS conceded a goal from a good header after a corner kick, which arguably could have been a foul against our Goalkeeper. However, students kept focused and started to regain control of the ball, with many great plays during the game which made the supporters proud of their team. In the second half, also after a corner kick, Chayse Shirley equalized with a great finish. Students and the crowd were buzzing and from now until the end of the game anything could have happened. NBIS had some good chances but so did HD. In the end our goalkeeper and defenders did a great job protecting our goal. The game came to an end with a 1-1 score, which led us to a penalty shootout. NBIS was leading it with our players scoring the first penalties (Sultan Alobed and Kenshin Hattori), and our goalkeeper (Biel Das Cervera) saved the HD's first shots. However, HD scored the next two while NBIS missed so the score was tight. In the end, Biel Das Cervera took the last penalty that was able to give us the victory, possibly because he just saved the previous penalty. Guess what happened then...Goooooooooooooooooal!! All the students ran and gathered together to celebrate the victory, what an end of a football day!

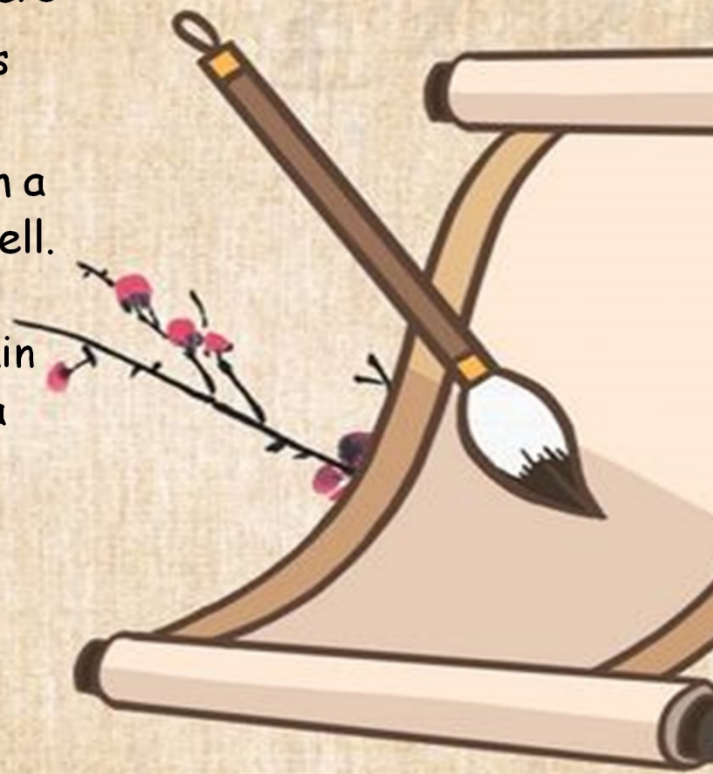

Scientific vocabulary and concepts can be challenging to learn and understand. One way of empowering students to become more confident is by doing experiments where vocabulary and concepts can be connected with visible and tangible examples.

Students are growing seeds, first in cotton wool, to observe the germination and growth of sprouts and roots. They have to sketch and write down the progress of their seeds' growth. Later, students will plant their seedlings in soil and do further observations on plant growth.

These experiments allow students to experience what they learn in class in real-time and develop various skills such as observing, scientific note-taking, and taking responsibility for the care of their seeds.

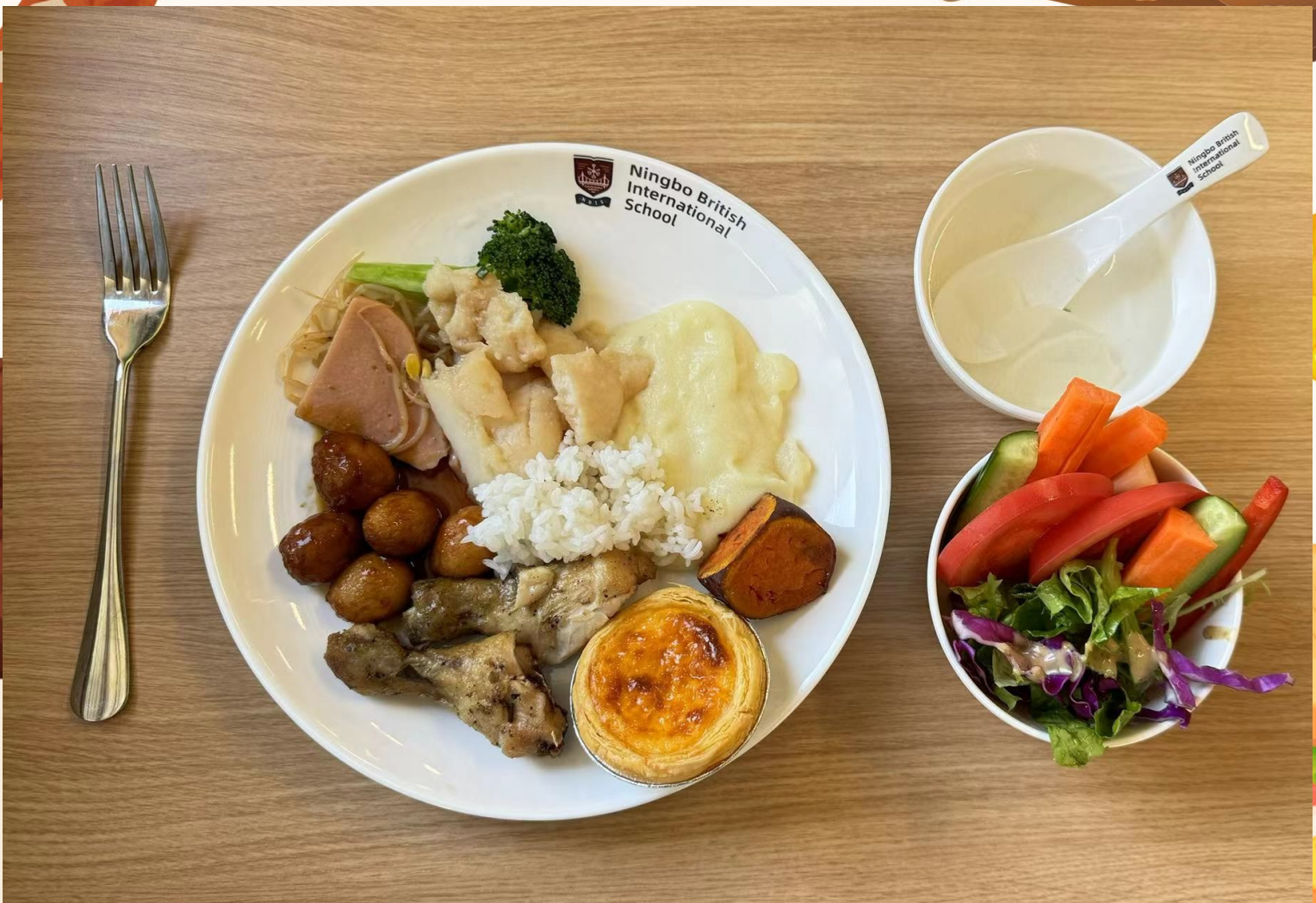

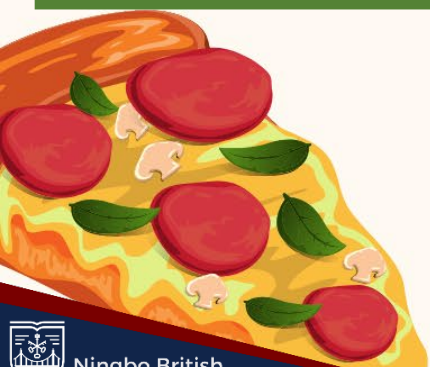
