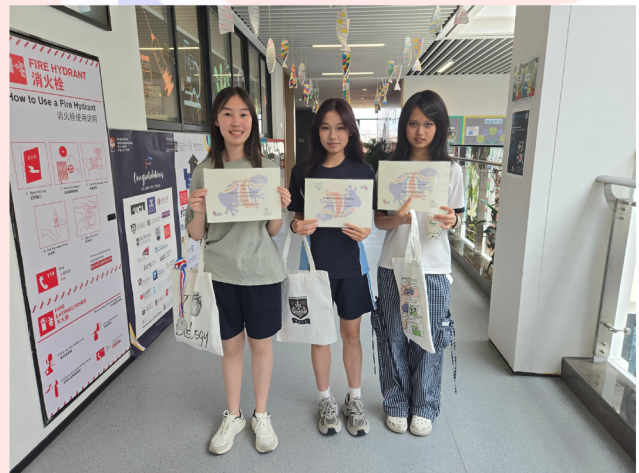


# Biology Challenge 2025

At the end of the last academic year, many NBIS students from Years 8, 9 & 10 entered the 2025 Biology Challenge to compete alongside over 42000 students worldwide. Since NBIS introduced Biology Challenge in 2021, 258 students have participated and won numerous awards. The Biology Challenge aims to stimulate a curiosity about the natural world and encourages students to take an interest in biology outside of school. Questions are set on the school curriculum, but the competition will also reward those students whose knowledge of the subject has been increased by reading books and magazines, watching natural history programmes, taking notice of the news media for items of biological interest, and are generally aware of natural flora and fauna. The competition consists of two multiple-choice papers which are sat online under exam conditions.

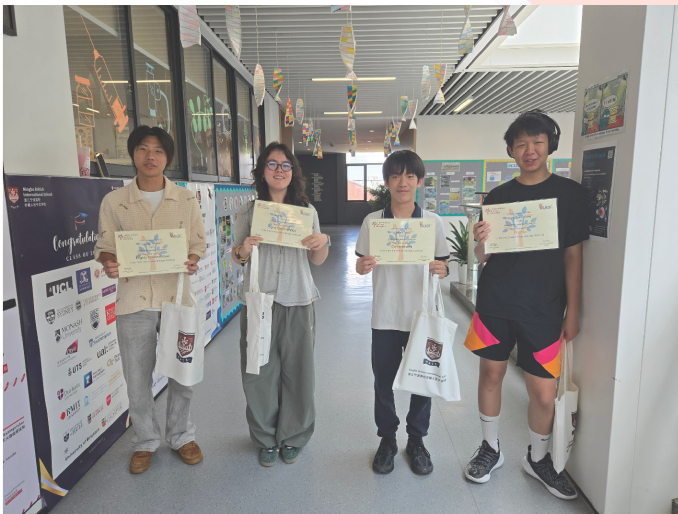

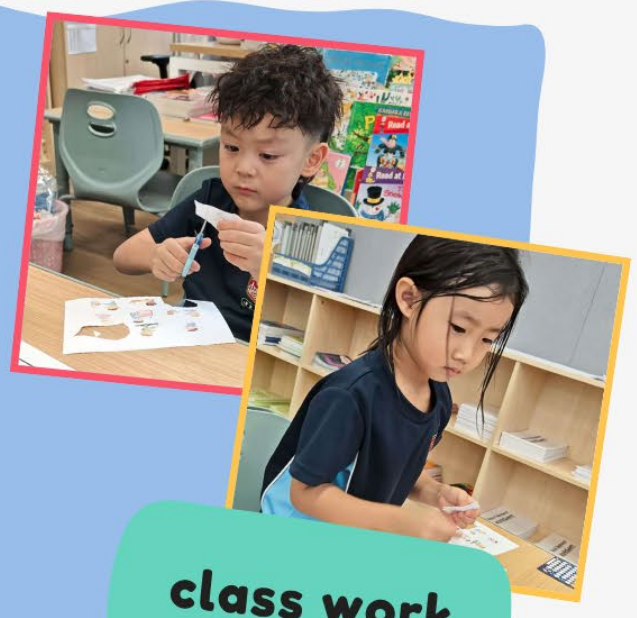


### Learn from our mistakes

## OUR CROSS-CURRICULAR APPROACH

Cross-curricular learning is fundamental to our philosophy because it shows students how knowledge is interconnected, moving beyond isolated subjects to create a richer, more relevant understanding of the world. Mirroring the interconnected nature of the real world, cross-curricular projects encourage students to build meaningful bridges between disciplines, preparing them for complex, multifaceted challenges, and enhancing critical thinking, creativity, and the ability to apply knowledge in diverse contexts.



This semester, students will engage in projects that exemplify this approach, such as:

- **STOMP Project:** This Music and Drama unit challenges students to use everyday objects and body percussion to create complex rhythmic narratives, exploring music as a physical and dramatic art form.
- **TED Talk Competition:** Continuing our successful Drama collaboration with the English Department, students will craft and deliver powerful speeches, enhancing their research, writing, and public speaking skills.
- **Stage Combat Masterclass:** A thrilling new collaboration between Drama and the PE Department this November! A professional fight director coming from Australia will lead students in a masterclass on safe and effective stage combat techniques, blending dramatic expression with physical discipline and control.

## DRAMA WEEK: A SCHOOLWIDE FOCUS ON IMPROVISATION

This November, NBIS will host its annual Drama Week, with a central theme of Improvisation. This focus will extend across the entire Expressive Arts Department, allowing students to explore spontaneity and creative risk-taking through multiple lenses:

- In Drama, students will explore spontaneous acting techniques, learning to think on their feet and build scenes collaboratively.
- In Music, year 8 will delve into Blues improvisation, learning the foundational structures that allow for expressive, real-time musical creation and storytelling.
- In Art, students will be challenged to create visual pieces 'in the moment', responding to musical stimuli, emotions, or other prompts, exploring the concept of improvisation in a visual context.
