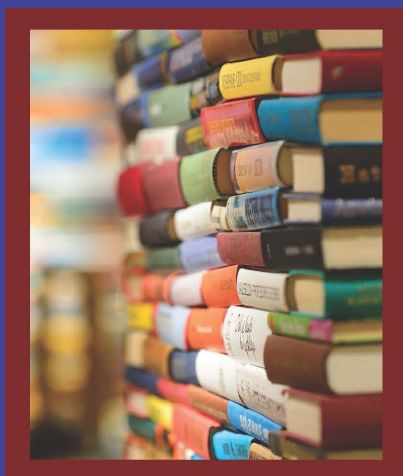
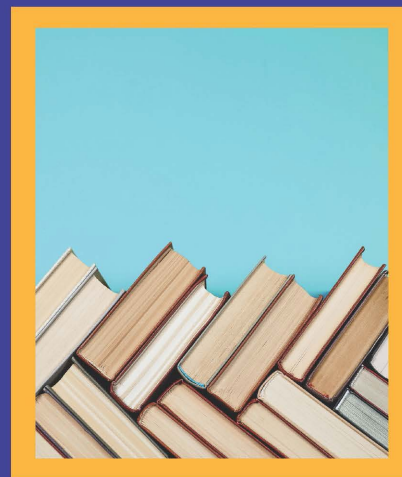

An Interschool Competition

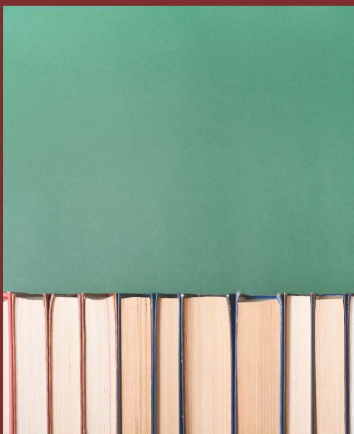


Battle of the Books is designed to introduce students to a variety of reading material, build teamwork skills, and ensure that reading is fun.

Students will be able to read books during the month of March, and the competition will take place in early April.

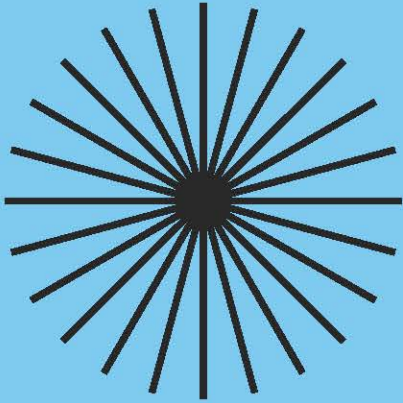

# **READ-A-THON**

The Secondary Read-A-Thon will take place from March 9th to April 9th.

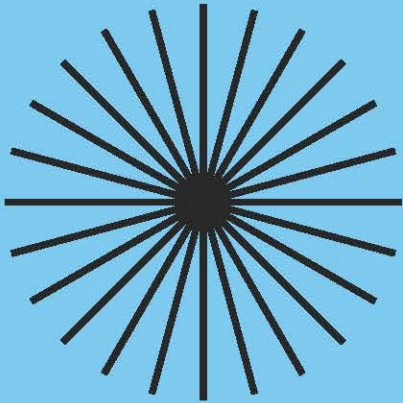


The secondary students have been challenged to read as many books as possible while raising money for a community animal charity. Students can collect sponsors for every book they read for the read-a-thon.



Friends and family can sponsor the number of books students read. Sponsors can pledge any monetary amount, e.g., 1 RMB per book or a flat amount. The reader is responsible for collecting the donations.

The books read need to be level-appropriate. English teachers must sign off on each book.



All proceeds will then be donated to a local animal charity called 'Stray Don't Cry'- an active charity that provides care to abandoned pets in Ningbo.

# **MAKE A PLEDGE**

Pledge to encourage reading and raise money for a local animal charity. The NBIS read-a-thon will take place between March 9th and April 9th, 2026.

There are two ways to pledge:

1. You could sponsor a student for a flat amount. If you pledge a flat donation of 20RMB, no matter how much the student reads, you will owe 20RMB.
2. You can pledge an amount for books read. For example, a student reads five books over the course of the read-a-thon. If you sponsored this student for 5RMB per book, you would owe  $5 \times 5\text{RMB} = 25\text{RMB}$ . You may limit any donation; just indicate that on the sponsor form.

- Keep science lab equipment away from flammable materials.
- Do not use personal gas cookers or hot plates in classrooms or dormitories.
- Keep classroom corridors and exits clear – never block fire routes.
- Know the nearest fire extinguisher and how to use it.



## Electrical Safety Tips

- Do not overload sockets with too many devices.
- Keep wet hands away from switches or plugs.
- Report damaged wires or sparking sockets to teachers or maintenance staff immediately.
- Switch off and unplug devices (such as projectors or computers) after lessons.

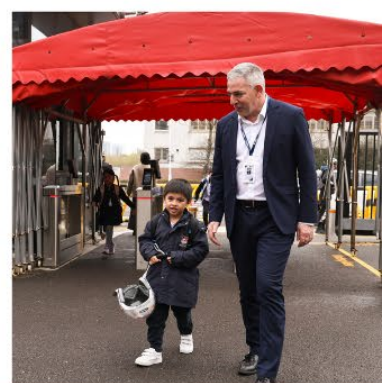


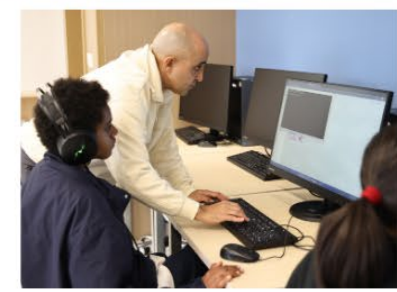
## SCHOOL STARTS | 02 MARCH, 2026

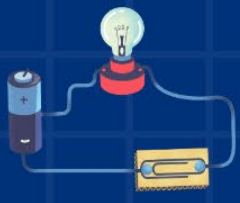
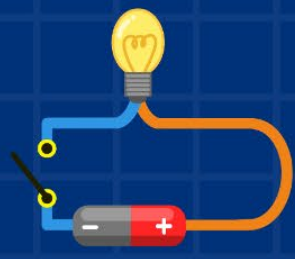
# BRIGHT SPARKS IN YEAR 2A: LIGHTING UP OUR LEARNING!

# NBIS Hosts Its First-Ever Science Bowl: A Celebration of Student Leadership

6 March 2026, NBIS successfully hosted its first-ever science quiz competition — the Science Bowl. Open to students in Years 10 to 13, the competition was a highly challenging academic contest and a true demonstration of leadership, academic depth, and teamwork.

We were delighted to welcome two international schools in Ningbo — Georgia School Ningbo (GSN) and HD Ningbo School — bringing together a total of 10 competing teams across the three schools.

## Student-Led from Start to Finish

As NBIS's inaugural science knowledge competition, the Science Bowl was largely organised and driven by students.

Every week after school, the student organising committee dedicated their time to building a comprehensive question bank. They carefully structured questions across multiple disciplines and difficulty levels, ensuring both fairness and academic rigor.

Beyond academic preparation, students, with the support of their teacher, Anthony Chen, coordinated with various school departments — including facilities, IT support, guest reception, and communications — to ensure the smooth execution of the event. The process evolved into a genuine real-world leadership experience encompassing planning, collaboration, and problem-solving.





## Beyond the Curriculum: Challenging Academic Depth

The questions extended beyond the standard high school curriculum. In addition to core subjects such as Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, the competition incorporated:

- Selected university-level concepts
- Analytical and higher-order thinking problems
- Application-based interdisciplinary questions

The competition tested not only students' knowledge retention but also their ability to apply concepts flexibly in unfamiliar contexts.

A particularly challenging segment focused on the spelling of advanced scientific terminology, emphasizing academic precision and language proficiency — an essential yet often overlooked component of scientific literacy.



## A Milestone for Academic Excellence

The success of NBIS's first Science Bowl represents more than a competitive achievement. It highlights the school's commitment to fostering student-led academic initiatives and nurturing leadership through authentic experiences.



Through collaboration, intellectual rigor, and initiative, our students demonstrated that science is not only about mastering content — it is about curiosity, communication, and leadership.

This inaugural Science Bowl sets a strong foundation for future academic competitions and student-driven innovation at NBIS.

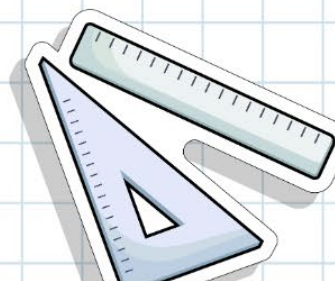
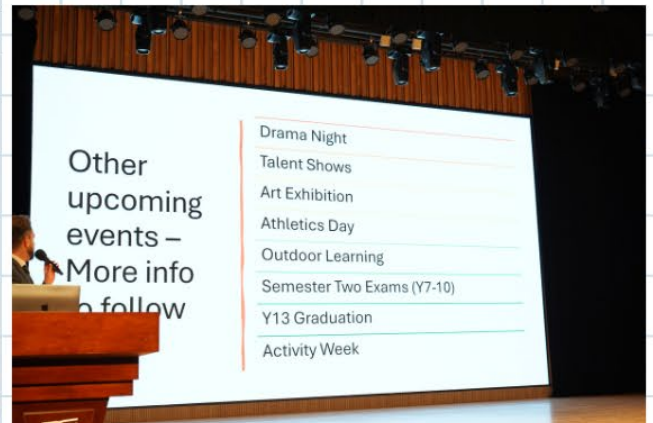

## Creativity Beyond the Classroom: Inspired by the World Around Us

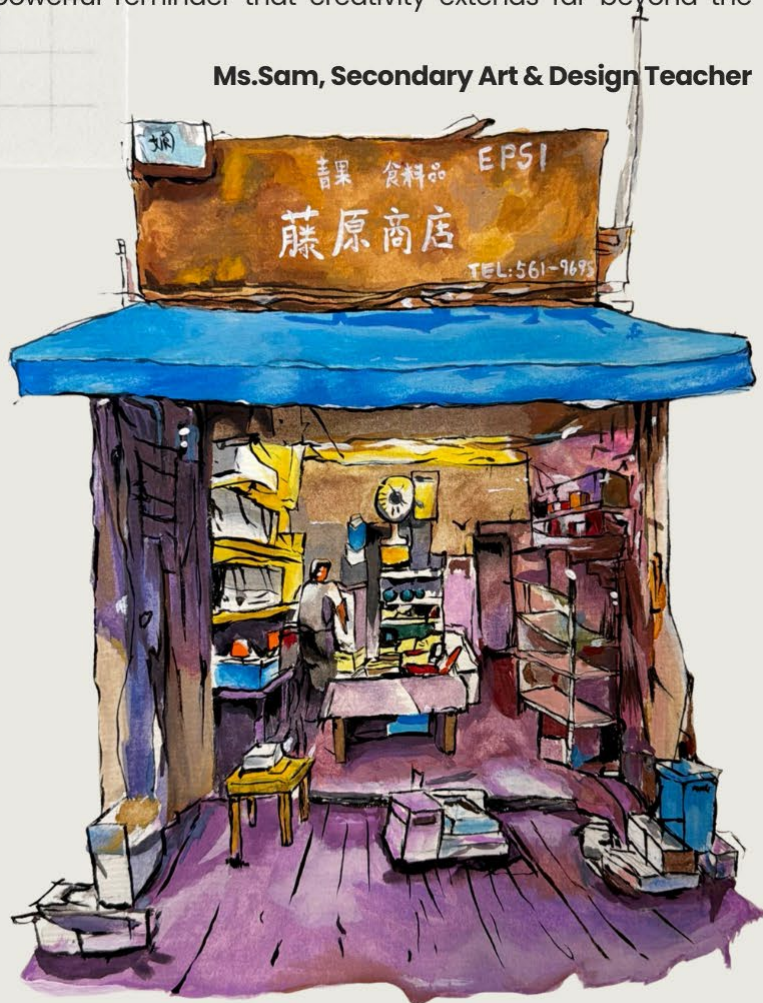
Over the Chinese New Year holiday, our IGCSE and A-Level Art students continued to strengthen their coursework in line with Cambridge's expectations. Remaining visually responsive to the world around them, students conducted personal photoshoots inspired by travel, architecture, family traditions, food, and everyday moments connected to their individual themes. This first-hand visual research forms the foundation of authentic and meaningful outcomes.

Alongside gathering primary imagery, students completed in-depth artist studies, analysing composition, mark-making, tone, texture, and media experimentation. The intention was not imitation, but understanding – exploring how artists communicate ideas and construct meaning in order to inform and elevate their own visual language.

Students will now move into the synthesis stage, combining their strongest photographs with carefully selected artist techniques to produce a resolved personal response. This process reflects the core Cambridge assessment objectives: research, recording, development, refinement, and synthesis.

We are extremely proud of the independence, discipline, and creative maturity demonstrated over the holiday. By merging personal observation with critical artist analysis, students are producing work that is technically assured, conceptually thoughtful, and distinctly their own – a powerful reminder that creativity extends far beyond the classroom.

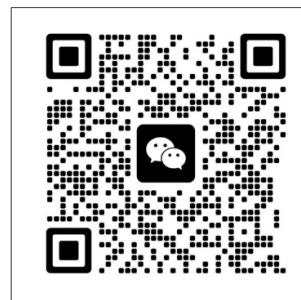
